- some cases code from 10 years ago
- Sun and partner code now intermingled
- OSS ones don't provide everything
- comparisons to OpenSolaris
- enlist communities help
- 3 font rasterizers - e.g.
- IP encumbrance

Probably like Sun contributor agreement

- Sun needs rights for commercial use and distribution
- But, they're open/want to share rights with contributors

- They're fine with Apple's Java distribution - What about Apple's "weird" distro?
- compatibility - They want code level behavior
